NOTICE INVITING BIDS

LEUCADIA WASTEWATER DISTRICT SAN MARCOS CREEK CROSSING DIVERSION PROJECT

The Leucadia Wastewater District (referred to as District or Owner) is requesting bids from qualified contractors for the Owner's San Marcos Creek Crossing Diversion Project (Project) which includes the installation of 10" gravity sewer pipelines, precast concrete manholes, cast in place concrete manhole bases; abandonment and demolition of existing sewer facilities; modification of existing manholes; sewer lateral reintegration; steep slope restoration; rock and boulder excavation; landscaping and surface restoration, pavement replacement, PCC pavement replacement, flatwork curb and gutter replacement, utility support and protection. All other work necessary to complete the work in its entirety including, but not limited to: providing bypass pumping system as necessary to complete the work of the project; protecting existing structures and facilities and maintaining sewer service at all times; completing site restoration; obtaining all permits and conforming to permit and regulatory requirements; trenching, backfilling, compaction; sheeting, shoring, bracing; traffic control; potholing; and protection or replacement of all existing utilities, structures, surface improvements, and all other existing improvements within the Work areas; restoring disturbed areas and easement areas and surface improvements to original conditions; and all miscellaneous work as shown, specified and directed for a complete operating installation.

The work will be located in the southern portion of the City of Carlsbad, California.

Sealed Bids will be received by the Owner at the Leucadia Wastewater District, 1960 La Costa Avenue, Carlsbad, California 92009 until 2:00 p.m. (local) on Tuesday, July 23, 2024 at which time they will be publicly opened and read.

Project documents, including Information for Bidders, General Conditions; Special Conditions; Specifications; Certificates and Affidavits; Contract; Payment Bond; Performance Bond; and Plans (collectively "Contract Documents") are on file and may be obtained at Mesa Reprographics, 5560 Ruffin Road, San Diego, California 92123, (858) 541-1500 or on line at https://mesareprographics.com/lwwd16 to view and order. The cost of Plans and Specifications is not refundable whether they are returned or not.

Bids shall be executed on the forms contained in the Contract Documents and in accordance with the instructions contained therein. Bid security, in an amount not less than ten percent (10%) of the total bid dollar amount, is required to be submitted with each bid. The bidder to whom the award is made will be required to furnish a payment bond and a faithful performance bond.

A non-mandatory, but strongly recommended, pre-bid meeting and walk-through of the work site is scheduled for 10:00 a.m. (local) time Tuesday, June 25, 2024 at the intersection of Corte De La Vista and Sondra Court, at the southeast end of the Corte De

La Vista cul de sac. The job walk will be conducted jointly by the Owner and Engineer. If you plan to attend the pre-bid meeting, please notify Ian Riffel (Owner's Project Manager) at iriffel@lwwd.org by close of business on Monday, June 24, 2024.

Pursuant to Section 1771 of the California Labor Code, the successful bidder shall pay not less than the prevailing rate of per diem wages as determined by the Director of the California Department of Industrial Relations. Copies of such prevailing rate of per diem wages may be obtained from California Department of Industrial Relations (DIR), Division of Labor Statistics and Research, (415) 703-4774 or may be available at the DIR website, http://www.dir.ca.gov. The Contractor shall post a copy of such determination at each job site.

Bidders and all proposed subcontractor(s) must be registered with the Department of Industrial Relations in accordance with Section 1725.5 of the Labor Code at the time of the bid submittal and must continue to be registered at all times they are engaged in the performance of work on the Contract.

Pursuant to Section 22300 of the California Public Contract Code, the Contractor may substitute securities for any monies withheld by the Owner to ensure performance of the work. Procedures shall be as provided in Section 22300.

All questions relative to this project prior to the opening of bids shall be directed to the Owner's project manager. It shall be understood, however, that no Specification interpretations may be made by telephone nor may any of "or equal" items be considered for approval during the bid period. Pursuant to the requirements under Permits and Licenses in the Information for Bidders of the bidding documents, bidders shall be Class A licensed in the classification of General Engineering Contracting as of the date of submittal of the bid documents.
